Cub Scout Summer Camp 2011 -- FAQs

What Is A Cub Scout Day Camp or Twilight Camp?

It is a great opportunity for your son to enjoy 3 to 5 fun-filled days with his fellow Scouts at one of our nearby Cub Scout camps. Day Camp is held during the morning and through the early afternoon. Twilight Camp is held in the early evening hours.

What Will My Son Do At Day Camp or Twilight Camp?

Our Scouts will enjoy tried and true camp favorites such as nature study, Scoutcraft, games, BB shooting, archery, skits, songs, and more. Some camps even have fishing and swimming available!

Do Parents Need To Attend?

Cub Scout Summer Camps are a volunteer effort. To ensure a successful and safe camp program, volunteers are needed to serve on staff or to assist the staff and guide the Cubs through each day's activities. There is ample (but not unlimited) opportunity to serve on staff. We are currently working to assemble camp staffs. If you are interested in serving on camp staff please contact your Camp Director to see if there is still a staff opening for you. It is important that we have adequate adult leadership with each pack so that the boys have the best experience possible. Talk with your Cubmaster or Pack Camp Coordinator about your availability and your wishes to help at camp. **Each pack should provide one adult for every 4 Cub Scouts at Day Camp or Twilight Camp.**

Can My Son Attend More Than One Camp?

Yes! The Gulf Ridge Council is offering 60 days and nights of Cub Scout camping in the months of June and July throughout our 8-county territory. Different volunteer staffs operate each camp, so the activities and experiences will vary from camp to camp. The cost for the 2nd (or 3rd, 4th, etc.) camp is reduced to \$65 per camp for Day Camp and \$55 per camp for Twilight Camp, provided that these registrations are postmarked **by April 29, 2011.** Call our Council Service Center (813-872-2691) or check our website for a complete listing of Cub Scout Summer Camps in the Gulf Ridge Council.

Fees And Registration

In most cases, for \$85 or less you and your son can join us for five fun-filled days of Cub Scouting adventure. Each Cub Scout will receive a Camp T-shirt (this is the uniform for the week that must be worn every day), craft and project materials each day, a specially designed camp mug, a commemorative patch, and all the fun you both can handle.

Please note that any parent serving on staff must be pre-approved by the Camp Director. Discounts no longer apply for any payments made after **April 29, 2011.**

Your Cubmaster and Pack Camp Coordinator have the necessary information for registration. You will register as a group with your Pack. ***Please do not send individual forms to the Council Service Center.*** However, if your pack is not attending, you may register your son at the Council Service Center. Please contact your Camp Director for further information and instructions.
